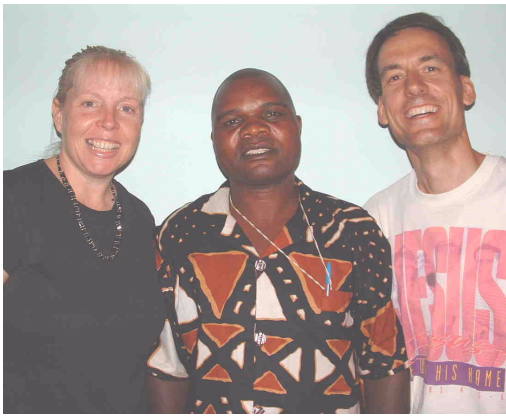
The Jordan River connects both these bodies of water. If this is true, why doesn't the Dead Sea have any life in it? Or, what has made it bitter?
